

# Eureka: Familiar Face For Deputy Andy

Eureka and Stargate fans got a double treat this weekend when Kavan Smith showed up as the newly-remodeled Deputy Andy. Formerly, Ty Olsson played the robotic officer; first as Sheriff Jack Carter's replacement in "Welcome Back, Carter" and then as his second-in-command for the episode "A New World." The old body got sacrificed for the greater good in the latter episode and he had to be rebuilt. The new model looks strikingly familiar to many viewers.



Kavan Smith is known to Stargate fans as Major Evan Lorne, who served on Atlantis as assumed second-in-command to Lt. Colonel John Sheppard for 29 episodes. Looks like Kavan's back in the galaxy and taken up the small town life in his new role.

This is not the first time Eureka has mined the Stargate franchise. Jaime Ray Newman (Lt. Laura Cadman, Stargate: Atlantis) had been a recurring character last season and into the beginning of this season. Eureka has also had a number of Stargate actors as guest stars in one-off roles. So, which category will Kavan Smith fall into? Will we see him again in the little town with a big secret? It's left unclear at the end of the episode, as Deputy Andy was sent back for repairs and possible body overhaul. However, you can catch Kavan in his upcoming roles, including the Syfy original Red coming later this year.
