

New Supernatural Anime Promo

A new promo for the Supernatural anime is out. And what is the soundtrack to such a preview? Why, none other than "Carry on My Wayward Son" of course! You can't have the show without the song. This promo also lets us hear some dialogue snippets so that we can get a feel for how Hiroki Touchi (Dean) and Yuya Uchida (Sam) are taking on the characters. Both these actors dub the characters in the live-action Japanese version as well, so I'd say they've got a pretty strong grasp on them.

The series, which is being done by MADHOUSE anime studio, will be 22 episodes that cover the first two years of the show. Instead of doing an episode-by-episode re-imagining for the anime format, the studio will be adapting certain scripts from the live-action while writing some all-new ones specifically for the animated version. This allows the series to delve into the boys' childhood, hunting on the road, as well as explore some supernatural creatures that can only be explored in an anime format. The Supernatural anime will be released in three sets: Volume 1 will have episodes 1-2, Volume 2 will have episodes 3-12, and Volume 3 will have episodes 13-22.

Seeing scenes from the re-imagined adaptations of episodes from the show, as well as episodes written specifically for the anime, has just made me more excited about its premiere. First release is set for January 2011.
