In preparation for the Season Six premiere of Supernatural, TNT will be having a 20-hour marathon of episodes September 23-24. The episode selection will rely heavily on the fifth season, but there are a few tasty selections from both the second and third seasons.

Thursday, September 23

12AM "Lucifer Rising" (Season 4 Finale) "He's coming!" It has always been leading up to this. Both brothers thought they were doing the right thing, but in the end neither could stop the coming apocalypse.

1AM "Sympathy for the Devil" (Season 5 Premiere) Hello, Lucifer, nice to meet you. You know you have a good character when you actually start feeling sorry for the Devil. Or at least seeing his point.
