

Supernatural Season 5 DVD Sales

In its first week of release, the fifth season of Supernatural ranked third in all DVD sales. The series garnered \$7,363,488 with 193,827 units sold as of September 12th according to [The Numbers](#). This beat out its CW rival Smallville, which released its ninth season on DVD with 166,680 units sold. Extras on the Supernatural DVDs included the Ghostfacers webseries, characters which originated on the show, as well as "Apocalypse Survival Guides: Bobby's Exclusive Video Collection", writer/producer commentary on the episode "The End", an unaired scene from the episode "The Real Ghostbusters", and the always-anticipated gag reel.

Season five of Supernatural closed out the five-year storyline that Kripke set out to tell, which started with

two brothers on the road fighting demons and ended bloody with the Apocalypse and the ultimate defeat of Lucifer himself. In the end, wherever the boys went and whatever supernatural beings they fought against, the final lesson was that it was all about family. As Chuck (God) so famously said in the closing lines of the finale, "Up against good, evil, angels, devils, destiny, and God himself, they made their own choice. They chose family. And, well... isn't that kinda the whole point?"

As the sixth season is set to begin on September 24th, fans look forward to where the new chapter in the Winchester adventure will take them. I'll definitely be tuning in! Will you?
